Origin

Haslingden Buff is a warm olive coloured stone quarried in the beautiful Pennines. A durable & dense sandstone that is extracted in large size format blocks offering endless possibilities for uses in architecture. A popular stone traditionally used for the pavements of Greater London and the terraces of private residences all over the UK, this stone will continue to be used for generations to come. Haslingden Buff is best known for its favourable technical properties as a building stone meaning that it is suitable for both interior & exterior paving, cladding and masonry applications being tested for suitability to the variations of the climate of the United Kingdom.
