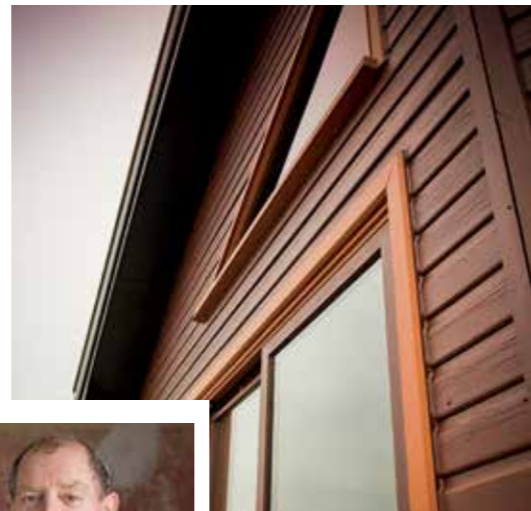

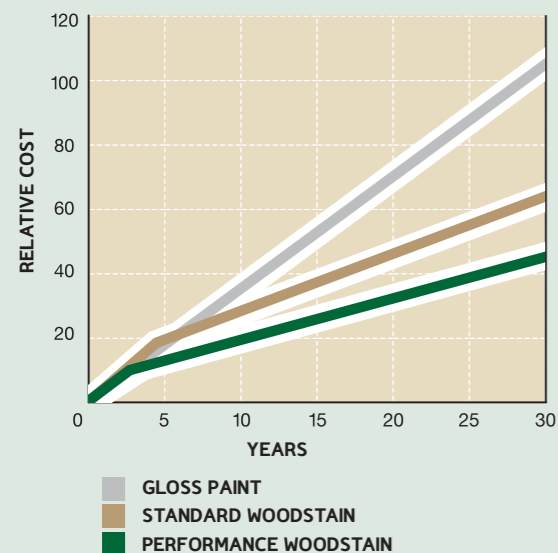


Cyclical Maintenance – Comparison Modelling

Instead of procuring solely on the basis of the impact the cost of a particular product will have on the current financial year, a Best Value approach takes a longer term view.

In the case of exterior cyclical maintenance programmes, for example, a cheaper coating may benefit the figures in year one, but how about the cumulative costs 30 years on? **ICI Paints AkzoNobel** has developed Cyclical Maintenance Comparison Modelling. The CMCM tool is software based and allows us to input information on a client's building stock and generate graphs that demonstrate the difference between maintaining stock using different **Dulux Trade** products.

This approach allows easy comparison of alternative coating systems, in terms of balancing initial and long term recurring costs to deliver the required end result. Variables such as product choice, the level of preparation required, labour and access costs and the desired maintenance cycle can all be factored in.



Comparison of re-decoration of external woodwork

Using variables from a typical housing stock maintenance schedule, the CMCM tool calculates that over a 30 year period an organisation will save 38% on its maintenance programme, by specifying a woodstain rather than standard gloss paint.

It is estimated that by specifying a performance woodstain over a standard woodstain, extending maintenance cycles from four to six years, cost savings of around 28% are achieved. A comparison between using a standard gloss paint versus a performance woodstain shows a 56% cost saving.
