# The Really Useful Group



### Customer/

Founded in 1977, The Really Useful Group exists to bring the work of Andrew Lloyd Webber to the world. The Really Useful Group manage his complete catalogue of works including theatrical and symphonic works, a requiem mass and countless rock and pop songs.

The Really Useful Group was also key in developing the casting by television and has licensed numerous copyrights to be exploited in this way, introducing a new, younger, generation to musical theatre. The pioneering BBC show *How Do You Solve A Problem Like Maria?* won an International Emmy, a Royal Television Society Award and drew nearly 8 million UK viewers. The format is now global, with theatre stars discovered through TV casting in Germany, Holland, Belgium, Canada and China.

### Challenge/

Moving from their existing offices within the heart of the West End in London where they have been situated since 1977, to a new building 200 yards away from their current offices, the challenge was to create a working environment that displayed the

creative and modern approach of the Really Useful Group, a setting and atmosphere that made an impressive impact to any visitor to the company and to ensure they would instantly recognise the work focus of the company.

Split over two floors, with an office working environment downstairs and a suite of meeting rooms upstairs complete with extensive IT and AV integration, the client chose a mixture of walnut and white timber finishes for the Cloud Cover Bench desking range, complimenting the office decor.

A light feel was required due to the extensive windows on one side of the building and therefore the clients choose the Ergo Vision Task chair range to compliment the workspaces. Storage was created in 'dead space' areas via a storewall system to ensure maximum storage space for all users supported with a special pedestal system for each individual person at their workspace.

A management suite of stylish glass offices, set across one side of the building, included individual personalised storage and used the Cloud Cover single sided workstations, to compliment the open plan office environment.
