All nora® rubber floorcoverings are free of any PVC, plasticizers (phthalate) and halogens (e.g. chlorine), they are also toxicologically safe in the event of fire – no hydrochloric acid, dioxins or furans are given off. Indoor air quality is increasingly considered to be a very important issue and nora® floorcoverings are regularly emission tested by independent institutions.

Today nora® flooring systems has no less than seven environmental awards including the 'Blue Angel', Greenguard Indoor Air Quality and the BREEAM 'A' rating.

This along with other characteristics offers an extremely long lifetime and extraordinary wear resistance under everyday conditions. A long working life means conservation of resources because of the relatively infrequent need for renewal and disposal. nora® floorcoverings can be installed in tiles or rolls using solvent-free environmentally compatible adhesives, and **norament** steptreads (including new DDA recommended steptreads). Skirting profiles can be installed using double-sided special tape only released for nora® products.
