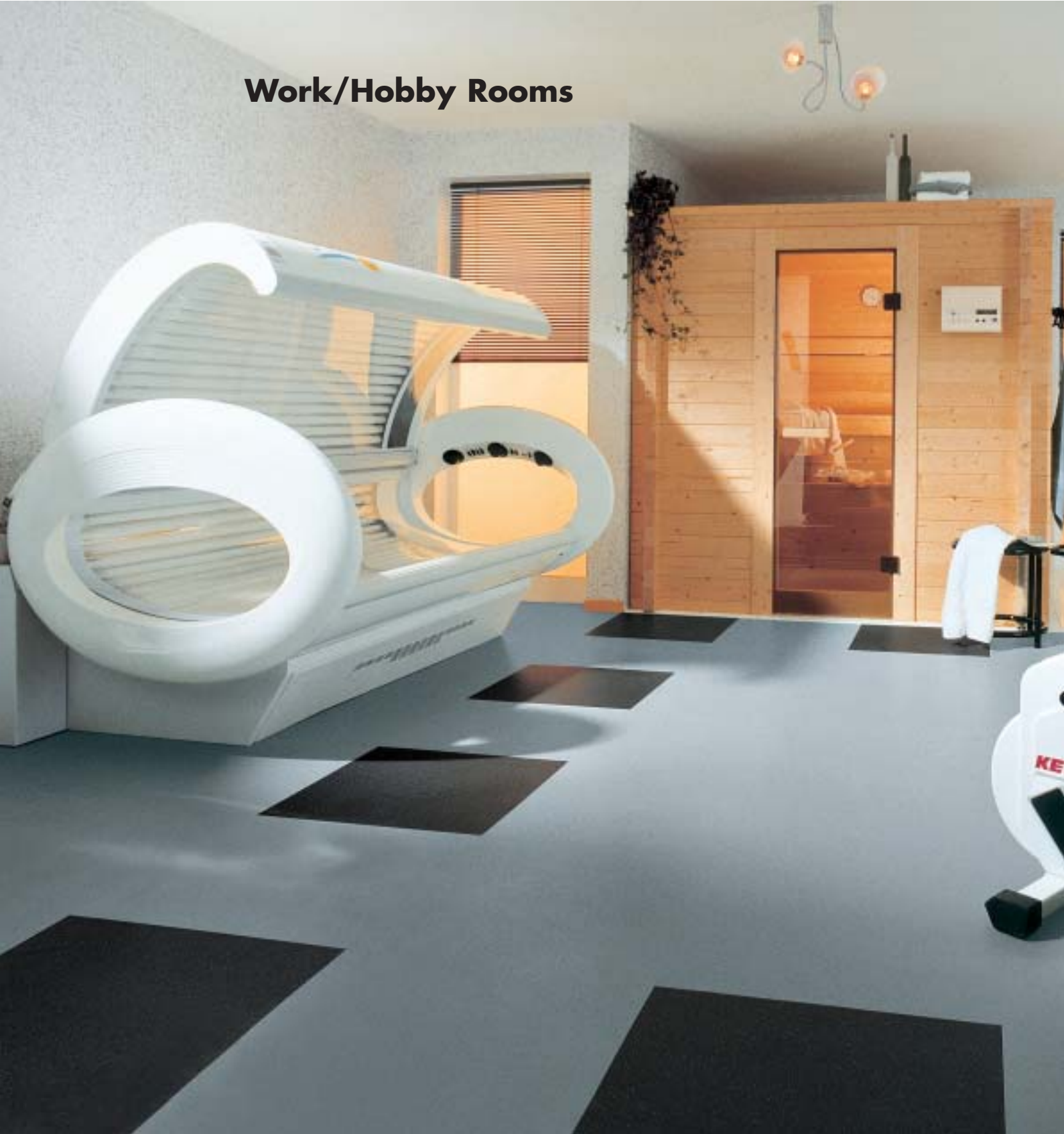
Bathroom

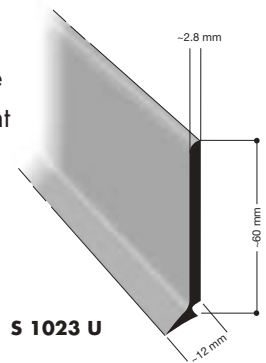

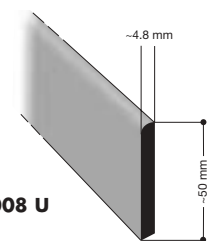

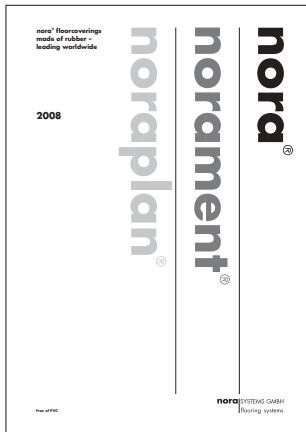

nora®

General:

The floorcovering may only be cleaned after the adhesive has cured/set, 48 hours after the installation at the earliest.

Cleaning and intermediate cleaning in case of heavy soiling:

Routine cleaning can be done immediately using suitable all-purpose cleaning agents.

The floorcoverings should occasionally be cleaned using polishing agents. Please observe the corresponding manufacturer's instructions.

Persistent dirt, wax and greases can be removed using suitable basic cleaning agents. The pH-value must be below 12.

The cleaning and polishing agents are available in supermarkets and drugstores.

Please observe the detailed instructions for use of the cleaning and polishing agents used.

Removal of stains

Spilled juices, coffee, tea, red wine, and rust etc. may result in stains on the floor-covering surface. For stains which cannot be removed using basic cleaners, special stain removers are available at the drugstore or in supermarkets.

Please, do not use hard/abrasive sponges or something near it for stain removal, otherwise the surface will be scratched.

Please observe the manufacturer's instructions.
