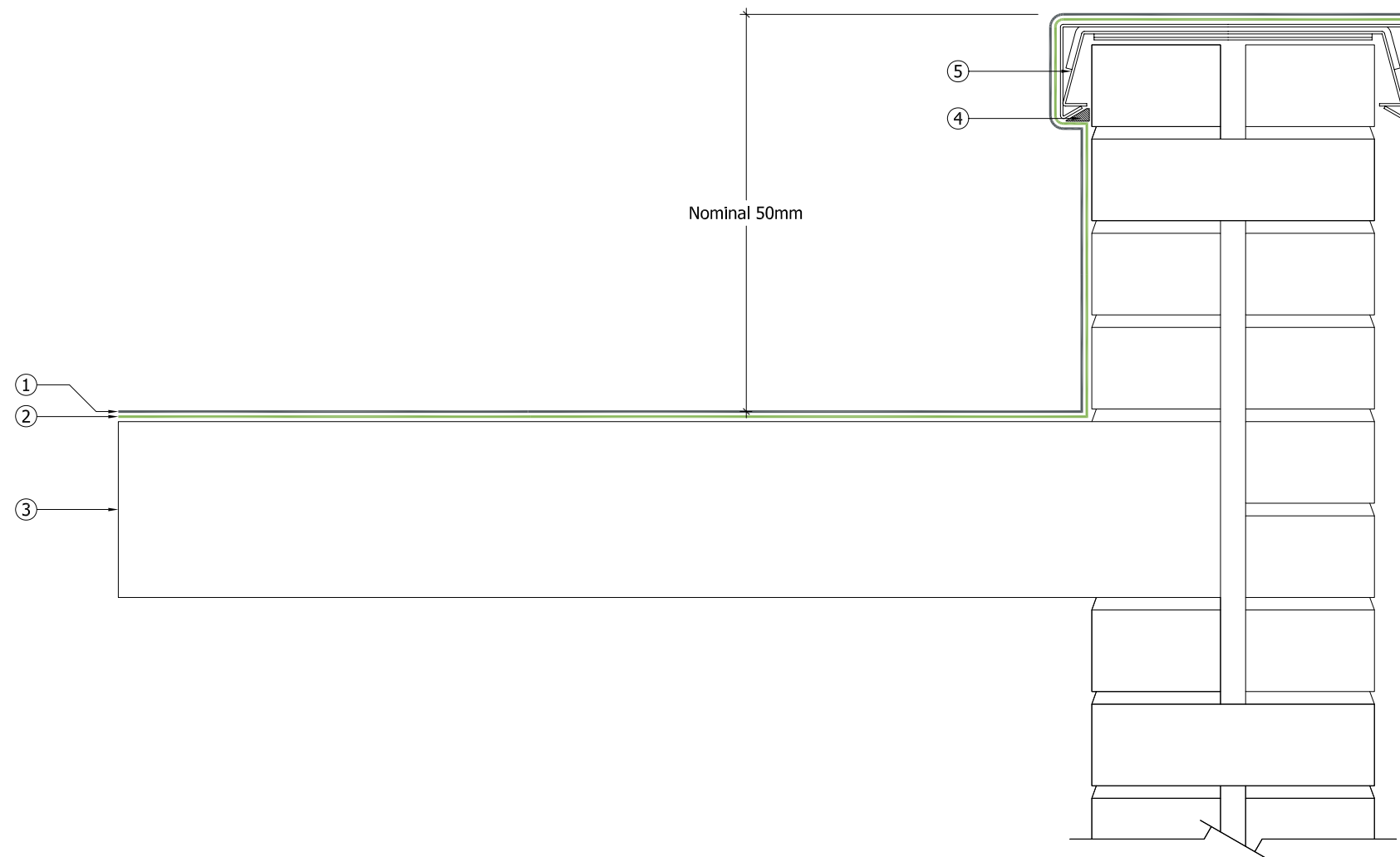


Key

 - ② — Decaflex Embedment Coat with Reemat Premium GFM
 - ③ Existing substrate prepared and primed in strict accordance with Sika Liquid Plastics Project Specification
 - ④ Compatible flexible fillers should be used where necessary to create a continuous surface on to which the fully reinforced Waterproofing System can be applied
 - ⑤ Existing metal cappings prepared and primed in strict accordance with Sika Liquid Plastics Project Specification; Waterproofing System terminated at a downward facing position on the external drip edge.
- NOTE:** A Bond Break Detail must be used on all capping butt-joints
