

How to use tuffgrit

tuffgrit used as bedding for unbound system

Lay 30-60 mm deep, depending on specification.

tuffgrit is laid high to allow for the bedding of paving elements and compaction of the tuffgrit bedding.

Hammer paving elements down to achieve level. Heavy Wacker plate compaction is used to vibrate cubes and setts to the desired level.

The paving should be jointed using the appropriate tuffsand stabilised paving grout.

tuffgrit aggregate used in a bound mortar-based system

tuffgrit may be used in the following ways:

As a bedding material when combined with tuffbed 2-pack.

As a rapid early strength gain bedding material when combined with tuffset G.

As a rapid early strength gain repair concrete when used with tuffset G.
